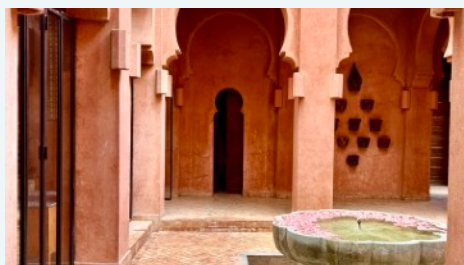

Explore the layered history of Tangier, Casablanca and Marrakech through private, expert-led tours of medinas, kasbahs and art deco landmarks—including Casablanca’s striking Hassan II Mosque and Marrakech’s opulent Saadien Tombs.

Step inside the private worlds of Tangier tastemakers such as Kenza Benani, Frank de Biasi and Umberto Pasti, and enjoy special access to Villa Mabrouka—once the home of Yves Saint Laurent and Pierre Bergé.



Immerse yourself in the culture of Morocco with shopping in the souks, a tagine cooking class and an excursion into the Desert d’Agafay for a camel trek and a Berber feast. Plus, enjoy visits to the Yves Saint Laurent Museum, MAP Marrakech (Monde des Arts de la Parure) and Bahia Palace.

Accommodations

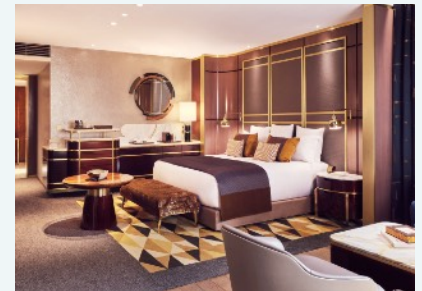
FAIRMONT TAZI PALACE TANGIER

Built in the 1920s, Tazi Palace served as a residence for one of the sultan's chief advisors—original architectural details showcase a romanticized, royal take on Moorish style. There is a palatial spa on-property, with access to a hammam, scrub room, steam room, sauna and indoor/outdoor relaxation areas and five restaurants.



ROYAL MANSOUR CASABLANCA

The second property in the Royal Mansour collection—which is owned by the king of Morocco—Royal Mansour Casablanca brings a welcome dose of luxury to heart of the White City. After an eight-year renovation, the property opened in April 2024 and became the city's top hote, with excellent service, Art Deco interiors, culinary pursuits and a wellness program.



LA MAMOUNIA, MARRAKECH

For decades, La Mamounia was where all the luminaries—from Winston Churchill to Catherine Deneuve—stayed. After a \$175 million renovation, the property offers a 27,000-square-foot spa, a heated pool pavilion and a rooftop lounge. It is both the center of the action within Marrakech's bustling medina and a true escape, surrounded by 20 acres of gardens.

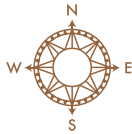

Itinerary



DAY 1, MAY 9: WELCOME TO TANGIER

- Arrival at the Tangier Ibn Battuta Airport; 30-minute car transfer to the hotel for check-in and time to refresh
- Guides will be available should any early arrivals wish to go for a stroll in the kasbah.
- Festive welcome dinner at the hotel

OVERNIGHT: FAIRMONT TAZI PALACE | MEALS: D

DAY 2, MAY 10: TANGIER

- Visit the Grand Socco, the lively plaza linking the medina and new town, and stop by the Cinema Rif, an Art Deco gem now home to the Cinémathèque de Tangier.
- Tour of the American Legation, the only American national landmark outside of U.S. borders and the oldest continuously operated diplomatic property.
- Step into the Petit Socco and explore the vibrant Medina before lunch at Riad Mokhtar, followed by shopping at the best boutiques.
- Visit Tebarek Allah, the villa of Italian horticulturist and writer Umberto Pasti, for dinner and a survey of his exceptional collection of North African tiles and antique textiles.

DAY 3, MAY 11: TANGIER

- Take a one-hour excursion south to Asilah, a whitewashed seaside kasbah and artists' haven set within 15th-century Portuguese ramparts.
- Enjoy a fresh seafood lunch at L'Océan
- Private audience with Kenza Benani, the Founding Director of the fashion label New Tangier. Kenza will share her design inspirations and the story behind her brand.
- Dinner at Villa Mabrouka, an oasis bought by Yves Saint Laurent and Pierre Bergé in 1990 that today exists as a 12-room boutique property surrounding by lush greenery.

Itinerary

DAY 4, MAY 12: TANGIER TO CASABLANCA

- Transfer to Tangier's train station to board your high-speed train to Casablanca (approximately a two-hour ride).
- Upon arrival enjoy Moroccan cuisine on the edge of the old medina.
- Explore the Quartier Habous, a French-built district blending tradition and modernity, with stops at Patisserie Bennis and the Marché Central along Mohammed V Boulevard.
- Check in to the Royal Mansour Casablanca, a restored art deco landmark, and enjoy dinner at Le Rooftop, featuring global cuisine with Moroccan flair.

DAY 5, MAY 13: CASABLANCA TO MARRAKECH

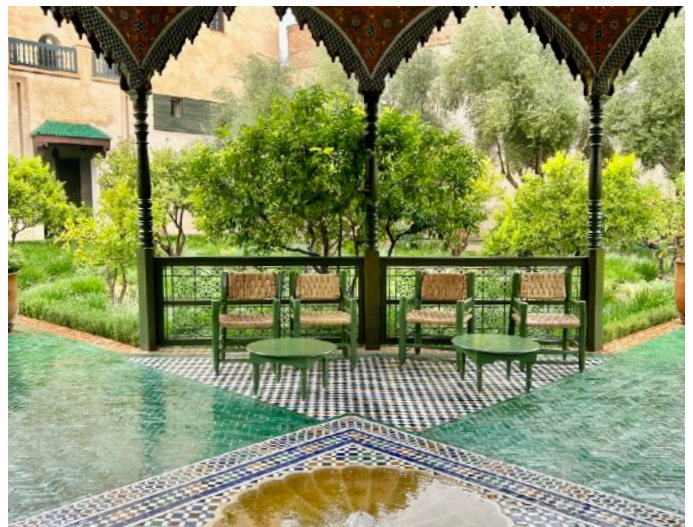
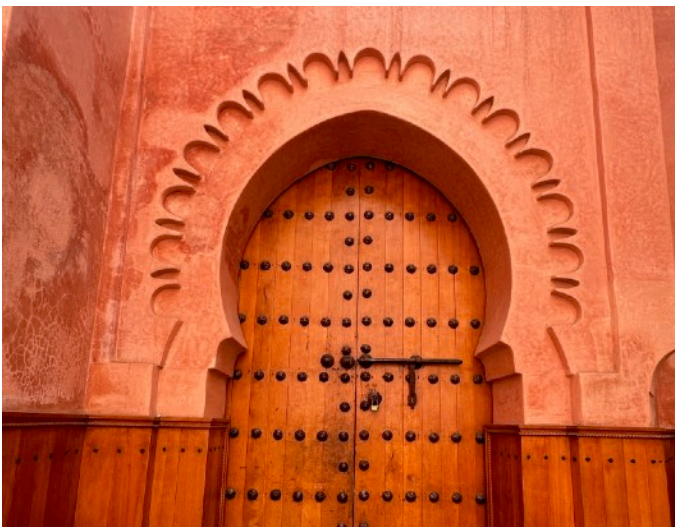
- Visit the Mosque Hassan II, the second-largest mosque in the Islamic world.
- Depart Casablanca and transfer to Marrakech (approximately a three-hour drive).
- Upon arrival, enjoy lunch at Grand Café de la Poste, followed by a tour of the opulent Saadien Tombs, the mausoleum of the great dynasty that once ruled North Africa.
- Check in to the iconic La Mamounia and take time to refresh before venturing out into the heart of the ancient, pink-walled medina to explore Djemaa el Fna, the busiest square in all of Africa, filled with food stalls, musicians and more.
- Dinner at leisure

OVERNIGHT: LA MAMOUNIA | MEALS: B, L

DAY 6, MAY 14: MARRAKECH

- Explore Dar el Bacha, a museum exploring the coexistence in Morocco of the three Abrahamic faiths, where you will see the recently restored Secret Garden.
- Lunch at L'mida Marrakech, a rooftop restaurant near the spice bazaar, before diving into the endless souks of Marrakech—including Topolina, Cherifia and Semmarine.
- Dinner at leisure

Itinerary

DAY 7, MAY 15: MARRAKECH

- Start the day with a visit to the Jardin Majorelle and Yves Saint Laurent Museum.
- Lunch at Petanque Social Club, named for its original incarnation as a 1930s club for the French community
- Shopping tour of Gueliz to visit some of Marrakech's top boutiques and ateliers.
- Drive to Desert d'Agafay, an arid, rocky area that is ideal for a taste of Moroccan desert culture. Enjoy a camel trek, followed by dinner in a Berber tent.

OVERNIGHT: LA MAMOUNIA | MEALS: B, L, D

DAY 8, MAY 16: MARRAKECH

- Enjoy a private hands-on cooking lesson at La Maison Arabe. Prepare a traditional tagine and classic Moroccan side dish for lunch.
- Embark on a curator-led tour of MAP Marrakech, a new museum in the kasbah showcasing a 3,000-piece collection of jewelry, textiles and objets d'art collected by Marlène and Paolo Gallone.
- Spend the rest of the afternoon on a tour of 19th-century Bahia Palace with its trapezoidal garden, or hire a private guide for more personalized exploration.
- Festive farewell dinner at the hotel with your fellow travelers.

OVERNIGHT: LA MAMOUNIA | MEALS: B, L, D

DAY 9, MAY 17: DEPARTURE

- Say goodbye to Morocco and check out of the hotel in time for your transfer to the airport, with VIP assistance, for your departure home.

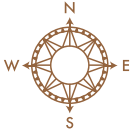

Know Before You Go: Global Rescue & Trip Insurance



Complimentary International Global Rescue Services Coverage

To help you travel more safely, responsibly and seamlessly, as part of your signup and registration, **all guests on International Indagare Journeys receive Global Rescue coverage for the dates of their journey as an added benefit.** Global Rescue is not travel or trip insurance, but in the event that an emergency occurs during the trip, guests have access to a variety of services, including medical assistance and evacuation assistance. Indagare also strongly recommend that you purchase additional travel insurance for your trip, in case an unforeseen emergency arises or you need medical treatment while traveling. Global Rescue Overview

Global Rescue was founded in 2004 and has five operations centers and offices in five countries, with 200-plus medical centers of excellence worldwide and 20,000-plus operations globally. Global Rescue operations centers are staffed by experienced nurses, paramedics and military special operations veterans.

For the duration of any Indagare Journey you have access to:

- **24/7 medical assistance and advisory services for natural disasters, terror attacks and civil unrest**
- **Evacuations from the point of injury / illness to home country hospital (pending the type of care and level of care needed)**
- **Travel intelligence services, including alerts and real-time destination reports for 215 countries**

Additional services include: symptom triage, referral to local hospital or clinic, urgent/emergency message relay, telephonic support, health information services, replacement of lost medical supplies & medical triage.

Additional Trip Insurance Recommendation

It is important to note that the **Global Rescue coverage that comes with every purchase of an Indagare Journey is not the same as travel or trip insurance**, which—among other features—offers financial protection concerning situations that occur before a trip begins and require a change or cancellation of travel plans. These can include a personal or family illnesses or other unexpected factors such as lost luggage, flight disruption, illnesses or accidents that require emergency medical treatment and/or hospitalization.

So that guests can plan and undertake travel with the minimum possible financial risks, **Indagare also strongly recommends that guests joining Indagare Journeys trips purchase travel insurance to cover their trip(s).** Travel insurance may be obtained from any of a number of providers that specialize in such insurance, and as a courtesy to guests, **Indagare can arrange for a quote for coverage with our preferred providers to be prepared and emailed directly to you at your request.**

Note: Plans from some providers can be purchased up to 24 hours prior to departure; others require 14 days notice. Indagare recommends opting in to a plan well in advance of your trip. Please be advised that Indagare is not a licensed insurance company or advisor.
