Indagare Virtual Souk: Alissa Ruxin's Rwanda Edit

ALISSA RUXIN moved to Rwanda 15 years ago on her honeymoon and never left. Raised in San Francisco, with a background in public health, with a focus on wellness, Alissa landed in Kigali ready to work with the community on improving health for all. While volunteering with orphans, Alissa saw a great need for vocational training and job creation, so she shifted gears, and built **Heaven**—Rwanda's leading restaurant and hospitality training facility. Since opening in 2008, Heaven has trained over 1,500 Rwandans in customer service, culinary and hospitality management skills. Over the years, she expanded the business to include the top-ranked 28-room Heaven Boutique Hotel. In 2014, she was the feature of *A Thousand Hills to Heaven: Love, Hope and a Restaurant in Rwanda*—a book penned by her husband and co-owner, Josh. Keen to develop a new luxury property for discerning travelers to Kigali, Alissa began construction of The Retreat, Kigali's most luxurious, eco-friendly and intimate high-end property. Alissa worked with a team of Italian architects and Rwandan builders and technicians to bring The Retreat to life. Since opening The Retreat in 2018 and her second restaurant, Fusion, Alissa has continued to expand its footprint and offerings. Today, The Retreat has a total of 20 rooms, with 8 new luxury pool villas, and her sister company offers curated tours and cultural experiences, featuring off-the-beaten-path destinations throughout Rwanda.


Since the opening of **HEAVEN RESTAURANT** in 2008, Alissa and Josh Ruxin have welcomed local artists and artisans to display and sell their work around the property. They now have the Heaven Arts Gallery onsite, which supports artists from all over Rwanda and is open for all to submit pieces for display and exhibitions. They specifically look for the highest quality, Made in Rwanda products and try to find cooperatives supporting communities in different ways. Some of the artisans were former street children, others have disabilities, some support vocational training, and all of the artisans the Ruxins work with are creating unique products for visitors—from jewelry made out of recycled materials and contemporary paintings to intricate handmade baskets. They are excited to be opening a new Retail Boutique at The Retreat which will continue to display and highlight products made by Rwandan artisans, fashion designers and entrepreneurs.

Abraham Konga is a Rwandan self-taught jewelry designer who upcycles discarded materials (like cow horn, cow bone, cooking pots, brass padlocks) to create jewelry of high quality and beauty.

Talking Through Art

Talking Through Art was founded in 2015 by Petr Kočnar, a young professional from the Czech Republic. Petr established his NGO in February 2015 with the dream of helping disabled people gain new skills, confidence, and a place in the job market. Talking Through Art now has over 80 members in Rwanda. They have also been able to identify sponsors to support children of their beneficiaries to attend schools. Their vision for the year of 2021 is to support over 50 children with parents with disabilities; they believe that education is a key to a better life, and a greater chance for the children to support their parents in the future. Their main activity is vocational training in traditional basket weaving. Talking Through Art also provides art therapy, English classes, family planning, and other life skills classes, all in an effort to build the confidence of their members, strengthen their self-esteem, and help them become independent and active participants of the Rwandan society.



African Fabric: Custom Made Products

The Retreat's onsite tailor, Maiga Aboubacar, was raised in a very large family with many siblings. He survived by working various jobs throughout his youth and was eventually supported by an Italian man who paid for high school and training in tailoring. After high school, he worked for his sponsor in a tailoring shop as his apprentice, before moving on to work in partnership with several other tailoring shops in Rwanda, where he perfected his technique and experimented with different African styles. Maiga now works full time as the in-house tailor for The Retreat at Heaven. He creates beautiful custom products using the colorful "kitenge," an East African cotton fabric printed in various colors and designs with distinctive borders, for clothing as well as tote bags, duffles, tablecloths & placemats, bathrobes and cosmetic bags... Maiga is an extraordinarily talented tailor who can make just about anything!



Cow Horn Products

“Jean Marie Vianney Habiyaremye, a former street child, is a young entrepreneur who grew up in the Bugesera district of Rwanda. He grew up very poor and was forced to the streets after dropping out of school in 2008. Jean Marie and 6 of his friends on the street were approached by a Japanese woman who offered to teach them vocational skills—specifically the art of transforming cow horn, which was traditionally thrown out as garbage, into high quality handicrafts. Jean Marie is now the founder and president of Cow Horns Kigali, an enterprise that produces different types of jewelry and ornaments from cow horns and hooves. Jean Marie and his team produce different handicrafts, including cups, plates, spoons, key holders, horns for decoration, earrings, bracelets, and necklaces. Jean Marie has not forgotten his roots or the generosity of the Japanese lady that helped turn around his life for the better. He is also engaged in charity work, training street children in craft making, and employing some of the top graduates of his training program.”

Rwandan Paintings: Indiba - Willy Karekezi

Willy Karekezi is a self-taught conceptual artist and founder of Indiba Arts who lives and works in Kigali, Rwanda. His work is driven by social and political engagement. He believes that art is without boundaries and that it enables him to tell stories and communicate to society. Through education programs and working within refugee camps in Rwanda and Uganda, he also contributes financially and emotionally through workshops, exhibitions and installations. To name a few, Willy has worked with the Moleskine Foundation, American Refugee Committee, UNHCR, European Youth Exchange Project and Kinderfreunde Austria. His work has been exhibited worldwide in solo and group exhibitions in The National Museum of Uganda; The Oglethorpe University Museum of Art in Atlanta; Green Circle, Vienna; Sprachsalon Berlin; and the London School of Economics and Political Science.




Rwandan Paintings: Indiba - Eustache U

Rwandan Paintings: Indiba - Mugabo B

“I am a contemporary Congolese artist working in Goma in the east of the R.D.C. I want to communicate through my art the reflections of the daily and historical experience of my community, in particular, but also of the mutation of man, in general, while asking questions about [colonizing], seeing that I live in a space where the culture still reflects a lot of colonial clichés. I created an aspect where we deconstruct colonial clichés to project themselves into a free space conducive to the creation of a new alchemy. My artistic approach is based on a freedom of use of several tools, [and] experimenting with different sensibilities, so sometimes I do abstract paintings with mixed media approaches; I use recovered materials that I stick on my canvases painted in acrylic on the other side, and I do street photography trying to capture the lively spirit of urban change, questioning the collective memory.”

Inshuti Art & Cultural Center

“Inshuti’s mission is to socially engage, develop and empower the community through various art trainings, and to exhibit a selection of superb Rwandan contemporary art to foster the enjoyment, understanding, and development of the visual arts in Kigali through diverse and engaging artistic experiences. Inshuti means “friendship” in Kinyarwanda. Inshuti’s vision is to provide space for innovative creative art and increase the desire for cultural understanding through studies, trainings, and exhibitions.
