

Those who only visit Siem Reap are missing the full understanding of Cambodia's past and present. In Phnom Penh, guests learn about the country's entire, and extraordinary, history, including the Pol Pot, Khmer Rouge and Vietnam War era—one of the most compelling periods in modern history. The totalitarian leader and his allies conducted a campaign to rid the country of the educated and the elite, a genocide that killed nearly one quarter of the country's population. Today's Cambodia is a country marked by resilience, rebuilding and recovery, with a young population who have come a remarkably long way in a relatively short time. Cambodia's history makes it exceptional not only in Asia but in the world, and this trip opens windows into both its long-ago and more recent periods.

# Itinerary

#### DAY 1: ARRIVAL

• Should you wish to arrive a day early to acclimate, Indagare can arrange a room for you prior to the day that activities begin. Airport transfers will be included for either day. Check-in is at 2:00 p.m.

#### OVERNIGHT: ROSEWOOD PHNOM PENH | MEALS: NONE

#### **DAY 2: PHNOM PENH**


- Arrival at the Phnom Penh International Airport (PNH) with VIP Fast Track assistance
- Venture into the surrounding countryside on an hour-long boat ride to the Islands of the Mekong river, stopping at Ratanak Villa for a relaxing afternoon and dinner.
- Your host chef will teach you about the rich history of traditional Cambodian cooking with a sumptuous tasting menu. Enjoy drinks by the pool, a refreshing swim or a stroll through the villa gardens while dinner is prepared. After, return to the hotel by car.

#### OVERNIGHT: ROSEWOOD PHNOM PENH | MEALS: D

#### DAY 3: PHNOM PENH

- City tour of Phnom Penh, including the Royal Palace and the National Museum, which houses the world's foremost collection of Khmer art.
- Visit to the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum, where professor Jean-Michel Filippi (*subject to availability*) will guide you through Cambodia's past and recent history.
- Stop at the Killing Fields Memorial at Choeung Ek Genocidal Center.
- Meet with graduates from the Harpswell Foundation—a leadership organization that supports Cambodian women—and learn how they create change in Phnom Penh over cocktails and dinner.

# Itinerary

#### DAY 4: PHNOM PENH TO SIEM REAP

- Depart for a seven-hour road trip to Siem Reap, stopping along the way at the villages, markets and scenic viewpoints along National Highway 6.
- Arrival in Siem Reap and check-in at Phum Baitang
- Dinner is at leisure. Indagare is happy to provide restaurant recommendations.

#### OVERNIGHT: PHUM BAITANG | MEALS: B, L

#### DAY 5: SIEM REAP

- Early morning visit to Srah Srang reservoir and Ta Prohm Temple
- Chef-prepared breakfast before seeing the less-touristed temple of Ta Nei
- End at Ta Keo Temple, the "Mountain with Bronze Peaks," and admire its five-tiered pyramid structure before returning to the hotel for lunch.
- Travel to the Victory Gate of Angkor Thom.
- As the sun begins to set on Angkor Archaeological Park, enjoy a traditional wooden boat ride along Siem Reap's ancient water system.

#### OVERNIGHT: PHUM BAITANG | MEALS: B, L, D

#### DAY 6: SIEM REAP

- Sunrise tour to witness the exquisite view of the sun emerging from behind the iconic lotus towers of Angkor Wat
- Explore detailed bas-reliefs depicting scenes from Hindu mythologies and battles of the ancient empire. Return to the hotel for a late breakfast.
- Afternoon at the private home and workshop of designer Eric Raisina, who will walk you through his design process (*subject to availability*)
- Dinner with a special Apsara dance performance

#### OVERNIGHT: PHUM BAITANG | MEALS: B, D











#### DAY 7: SIEM REAP

- 50-minute drive to Banteay Srei, a temple known for its intimate size and intricate carvings
- Lunch at Chanrey Tree
- Special visit to Angkor Conservation
- Experience the best of Siem Reap, as you move from venue to venue on a food tour.

#### OVERNIGHT: PHUM BAITANG | MEALS: B, L, D

#### **DAY 8: SIEM REAP**

- Join an art historian for a tour of Siem Reap's creative community before lunch at a local restaurant and shopping at Kandal Village.
- Tonight, you will head into the Cambodian countryside for a unique dining experience amid the rice paddies.

#### OVERNIGHT: PHUM BAITANG | MEALS: B, L, D

#### **DAY 9: DEPARTURE**

• Transfer to the airport, where you will have VIP Fast Track assistance for your departure flight homeward.

### Know Before You Go: Global Rescue & Trip Insurance

#### Complimentary International Global Rescue Services Coverage

To help you travel more safely, responsibly and seamlessly, as part of your signup and registration, all guests on International Private Journeys receive Global Rescue coverage for the dates of their journey as an added benefit. This means that in the event that an emergency occurs during the trip, guests have access to a variety of services, including medical assistance and evacuation assistance.

#### **Global Rescue Overview**

Global Rescue was founded in 2004 and has five operations centers and offices in five countries, with 200+ medical centers of excellence worldwide and 20,000+ operations globally. Global Rescue operations centers are staffed by experienced nurses, paramedics and military special operations veterans.

#### For the duration of any Private Journey you have access to:

- 24/7 medical assistance and advisory services for natural disasters, terror attacks and civil unrest.
- Evacuations from the point of injury/illness to home country hospital (at no additional cost)
- Travel intelligence services, including alerts and real-time destination reports for 215 countries

Additional services include: symptom triage, referral to local hospital or clinic, urgent/emergency message relay, telephonic support, health information services, replacement of lost medical supplies & medical triage.

#### **Additional Trip Insurance Recommendation**

It is important to note that the **Global Rescue coverage that comes with every purchase of a Private Journey is not the same as travel or trip insurance,** which—among other features—offers financial protection concerning situations that occur before a trip begins and require a change or cancellation of travel plans. These can include a personal or family illnesses or other unexpected factors such as lost luggage, flight disruption, illnesses or accidents that require emergency medical treatment and/or hospitalization.

So that guests can plan and undertake travel with the minimum possible financial risks, **Indagare also** strongly recommends that guests joining Private Journeys trips purchase travel insurance to cover their trip(s). Travel insurance may be obtained from any of a number of providers that specialize in such insurance, and as a courtesy to guests, **Indagare can arrange for a quote for coverage with our preferred** providers to be prepared and emailed directly to you at your request.
