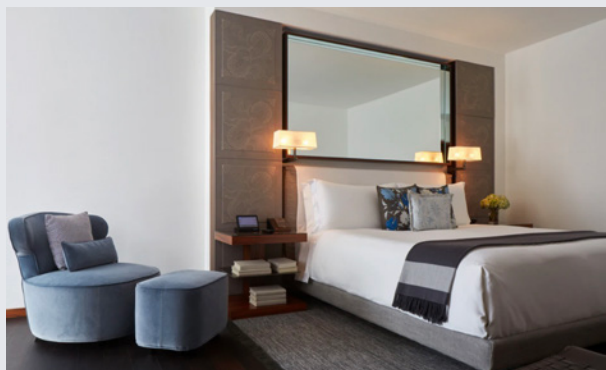

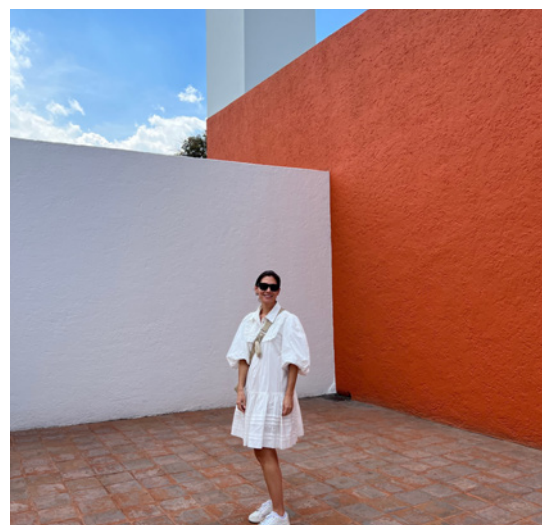
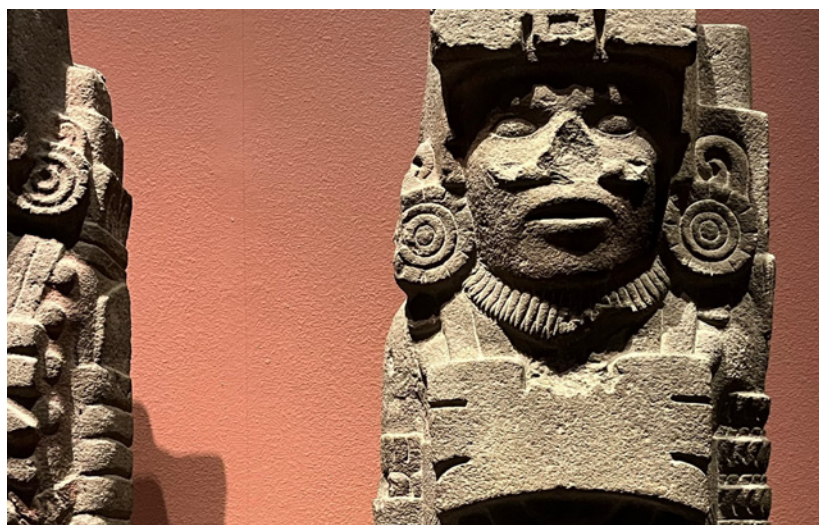

Itinerary

DAY 1: ARRIVAL

- Upon arrival at the Mexico City International Airport (MEX), meet your private driver and transfer to the Las Alcobas hotel for check-in.
- Exclusive after-hours tour of Mexico City's most-visited museum: the National Anthropology Museum—enjoy the entire collection to yourself with an expert guide
- Welcome dinner at one of Mexico City's top restaurants

OVERNIGHT: LAS ALCOBAS | MEALS: D

DAY 2: CUISINE & ARCHITECTURE

- Private tour of Casa Luis Barragán—the only private property in Latin America to be named a UNESCO World Heritage Site—with an expert guide. Access spaces that are ordinarily closed to the public (*subject to availability*).
- Visit Casa Gilardi, the last home Barragán designed before his death, and Casa Ortega, with its beautiful gardens. Afterwards, enjoy lunch at a top local restaurant.
- Join a curator to discover some of the most influential art galleries, design studios and creative collectives that define Mexico City's culture scene.
- Dinner at leisure. Indagare is happy to provide restaurant recommendations.

OVERNIGHT: LAS ALCOBAS | MEALS: B, L

DAY 3: HISTORY & ART

- After breakfast, meet your guide to explore two southern neighborhoods of Mexico City—San Ángel and Coyoacán—which feel like small villages despite being part of the capital.
- Dive into the world of Mexico City's most tumultuous and talented couple, Diego Rivera and Frida Kahlo, with a curator-led tour of their former home and studio.
- After lunch at Tetelán, enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure for independent exploring or shopping. Dinner at leisure. Indagare is happy to provide restaurant recommendations.

Itinerary

DAY 4: TEOTIHUACÁN

- After an early breakfast, drive to the Teotihuacán archaeological complex to view its pyramids and ruins with an expert guide (*approximately a one-hour drive*).
- Return to Mexico City for lunch and spend the afternoon and dinner at leisure. Indagare is happy to provide restaurant recommendations.

DAY 5: MEXICO CITY CUISINE & MEZCAL

- After a leisurely morning, set off for your hands-on Mexican cooking class and mezcal tasting. The rest of the afternoon is at leisure.
- Festive farewell dinner at one of Mexico City's top restaurants

- Check out from the hotel in time for your transfer to the Mexico City International Airport (MEX) for your departure flight home.

Know Before You Go: Global Rescue & Trip Insurance

Complimentary International Global Rescue Services Coverage

*To help you travel more safely, responsibly and seamlessly, as part of your signup and registration, **all guests on International Private Journeys receive Global Rescue coverage for the dates of their journey as an added benefit.*** This means that in the event that an emergency occurs during the trip, guests have access to a variety of services, including medical assistance and evacuation assistance.

Global Rescue Overview

Global Rescue was founded in 2004 and has five operations centers and offices in five countries, with 200+ medical centers of excellence worldwide and 20,000+ operations globally. Global Rescue operations centers are staffed by experienced nurses, paramedics and military special operations veterans.

For the duration of any Private Journey you have access to:

- **24/7 medical assistance and advisory services for natural disasters, terror attacks and civil unrest**
- **Evacuations from the point of injury/illness to home country hospital (at no additional cost)**
- **Travel intelligence services, including alerts and real-time destination reports for 215 countries**

Additional services include: symptom triage, referral to local hospital or clinic, urgent/emergency message relay, telephonic support, health information services, replacement of lost medical supplies & medical triage.

Additional Trip Insurance Recommendation

It is important to note that the **Global Rescue coverage that comes with every purchase of a Private Journey is not the same as travel or trip insurance**, which—among other features—offers financial protection concerning situations that occur before a trip begins and require a change or cancellation of travel plans. These can include a personal or family illnesses or other unexpected factors such as lost luggage, flight disruption, illnesses or accidents that require emergency medical treatment and/or hospitalization.

So that guests can plan and undertake travel with the minimum possible financial risks, **Indagare also strongly recommends that guests joining Private Journeys trips purchase travel insurance to cover their trip(s).** Travel insurance may be obtained from any of a number of providers that specialize in such insurance, and as a courtesy to guests, **Indagare can arrange for a quote for coverage with our preferred providers to be prepared and emailed directly to you at your request.**

Note: Plans from some providers can be purchased up to 24 hours prior to departure; others require 14 days notice. Indagare recommends opting in to a plan well in advance of your trip. Please be advised that Indagare is not a licensed insurance company or advisor.
